Rep. David Miller appeared before the Committee to comment on the rules.

House Bill 2072, a technical bill which changes the name of the "Ways and Means" Committee to "Appropriations," was introduced. A motion was made by Rep. R.H. Miller to recommend to the Speaker that the bill be referred to the Committee of the Whole. The motion was seconded by Rep. David Heinemann.

The motion passed.

Rep. Miller moved to recommend that the House Concurrent Resolution of the Senate and House joint rules be introduced and referred to the Committee of the Whole. Rep. Heinemann seconded that motion.

The motion passed.

In House Resolution 6005, Rep. Miller motioned to strike what was Rule 2106 and insert "No substitute motion to amend a bill or resolution shall be in order"; thereby prohibiting substitute motions. The motion was seconded by Rep. Heinemann.

The motion passed.

Rep. Heinemann moved that House Resolution 6005 be reported favorably as passed. Rep. Miller seconded the motion.

The motion passed.

The Minutes of January 15 were approved.
