The meeting was called to order by Chairman Crowell and the first order of business was discussion and action on SB-395 concerning speed limits on highways.

Staff briefed the Committee and said SB-395 allows the increase of speed limits on rural interstate highways to 65 mph.

A motion was made by Representative Laird that SB-395 be recommended favorable for passage. Motion died for lack of a second.

A motion was made by Representative Freeman that SB-395 be amended to allow a 5 mph grace on the 65 mph speed for purposes of being a moving violation. The motion was seconded by Representative Wilbert. Motion passed.

A motion was made by Representative Shore that SB-395 be amended to require county names on the bottom of the new license plates. The county name would be placed on the license plate by a decal that would be at least 3/4 of an inch high. The motion was seconded by Representative Moomaw. Motion passed.

A motion was made by Representative Moomaw that SB-395 be recommended favorable as amended for passage. The motion was seconded by Representative Harper.

Motion passed.
