The meeting was called to order by Chairman Crowell, and the first order of business was a hearing on SB-380 concerning clinging to the outside of a moving vehicle.

Staff briefed the Committee concerning SB-380 and said there have been problems in Johnson County with persons riding on the outside of vehicles, and officers were unable to issue citations since there are no laws against this.

A motion was made by Representative Wilbert that SB-380 be recommended favorable for passage. The motion died for lack of a second.

A substitute motion was made by Representative Smith that pickup beds be excluded from SB-380. The motion was seconded by Representative Moomaw. Substitute motion carried.

A motion was made by Representative Moomaw that the fine for clinging to the outside of a moving vehicle be reduced from \$20 to \$10. The motion was seconded by Representative Shore. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Representative Smith that SB-380 be recommended as amended favorable for passage. The motion was seconded by Representative Wilbert. Motion carried.
