SB 420 - An act concerning special education for exceptional children; affecting the computation of the amount of state aid entitlement of school districts for the provision thereof. (Ways and Means)

Following a call to order, the Chairman explained that SB 420 would reduce the count of the special education teacher who is a paraprofessional from .5 to .4 for the purpose of state aid entitlement. The Chair announced that the floor was open for discussion of the bill. Hearing no response, the Chair announced that he would entertain motions from the floor. Senator Anderson moved, and Senator Arasmith seconded the motion to recommend SB 420 favorably for passage. The motion carried.
