Senate Bill 14 - Diversion of criminal complaints, procedure.

The chairman discussed the bill. Following discussion, it was the consensus of the committee to table the bill with the idea it could be brought up again if additional information is provided.

Senator Steineger moved to table the bill. Senator Langworthy seconded the motion, and the motion carried.

Senate Bill 25 - Limitations on liability of certified public accountants.

The chairman reported he was informed by a representative of the CPAs that they had talked with the bankers and savings and loan people; they have come up with some proposals to make the bill more agreeable to all parties. The bill will be brought up on Tuesday, February 3.

Seante Bill 15 - Authorized dispositions under juvenile offenders code.

The chairman reviewed the bill. Following considerable committee discussion, Senator Steineger moved to amend the bill by striking new Section 2 and other language associated with Section 2. Senator Burke seconded the motion. The motion failed.

Senator Hoferer moved to report the bill favorably. Senator Parrish seconded the motion. On a vote of four in favor and three opposed the motion carried. Senators Feleciano, Steineger and Burke requested their "no" vote be recorded in the minutes.

The meeting adjourned.
