A list was passed out to the committee members indicating the bills that will not receive a hearing. Senator Steineger wanted to go on record he requested the committee take action on Senate Bill 110.

Senate Bill 234 - Motor vehicle liability insurance; special mobile equipment exemption.

Following committee discussion, Senator Feleciano moved to report the bill adversely. Senator Gaines seconded the motion, and the motion carried.

Senate Bill 236 - Authorizing use of forfeited controlled substances to train dogs for controlled substance detection.

Following considerable committee discussion, Senator Talkington moved to report the bill favorably. Senator Burke seconded the motion, and the motion carried.

Senate Bill 256 - Civil remedies for theft.

Following review of the bill and committee discussion, Senator Gaines moved to table the bill. Senator Winter seconded the motion, and the motion carried.

Senate Bill 257 - Criminal procedure, taking of depositions.

Senator Gaines moved to report the bill favorably. Senator Steineger seconded the motion. Following committee discussion, the motion carried.

Senate Bill 273 - Crimes and punishments, fraud in obtaining accommodations.

Senator Burke moved to report the bill favorably. Senator Parrish seconded the motion. Following committee discussion, the motion carried.

Senate Bill 261 - Penalties for transporting open container of alcohol or beer.

Considerable committee discussion was held on the bill. Senator Gaines
