Senate Bill 408 - Impairing a security interest.

Austin Nothern, Kansas Bankers Association, explained this bill was requested by the district attorney's office in Wichita. The statute, K.S.A. 21-3734, deals with damaging of property or selling and failing to account for proceeds of the sale for the secured party. The requirements of the crime was intent to defraud the secured party, and intent to defraud was not contained in the specific requirements. This bill attempts to cure that and put into the statute the intention to defraud which is under the criminal code at this time.

Following committee discussion, Senator Gaines moved to amend the bill to increase the dollar amount to one hundred fifty dollars. Senator Parrish seconded the motion, and the motion carried.

Senator Gaines moved to report the bill favorably as amended. Senator Parrish seconded the motion, and the motion carried.

Senate Bill 372 - Kansas parole board, membership, decisions.

Committee discussion was held on the bill.
