Senate Bill 372 - Kansas parole board, membership, decisions.

The chairman explained the reason for the meeting is the governor's office would like to see some action taken on this bill. The governor is interested in the bill providing the decisions of the board be by majority vote.

Following committee discussion, Senator Gaines moved to amend the bill to provide the chairman of the parole board be appointed by the governor and be given the authority to organize and administer the board. Senator Burke seconded the motion, and the motion carried.

Senator Gaines moved to amend the bill by deleting "All" in line 59 and deleting all of the language in line 60. Senator Burke seconded the motion, and the motion carried.

Senator James Francisco was recognized to discuss with the committee a change in good-time credit. He also stated he felt there should be more of an incentive for participation in the parole hearings by the legislators. He passed around a copy of the minutes of parole hearings by the Kansas Parole Board (See Attachment I).

Senator Gaines moved to report the bill favorably as amended. Senator Burke seconded the motion, and the motion carried.

A committee member stated that programming, beds and some help for the parole board are necessary to get a handle on the parole board problem.

The chairman stated with a movement to keep bodies in the prisons to keep them full so new prisons will be built, there is little the legislature can do.

The meeting adjourned.
