Senator Arasmith moved that HB 2038 be recommended favorable for passage. Senator Thiessen seconded. Motion carried.

Arden Ensley showed the Committee some amendments to HB 2039 he had prepared at the request of Chairman Yost. The amendments were designed to address some concerns raised by Sedgwick County Election Commissioner Marilyn Chapman pertaining to when the new precinct maps, ordered under HB 2039, would take effect. Senator Arasmith moved that the amendments be adopted, seconded by Senator Francisco. Motion carried. Senator Arasmith moved that HB 2039 be passed as amended, seconded by Senator Thiessen. Motion carried.

Arden Ensley showed the Committee some amendments to HCR 5003 which had been prepared at the request of Chairman Yost. The amendments were technical clean-ups. Senator Arasmith moved that these amendments be adopted, seconded by Senator Salisbury. Senator Johnston made a substitute motion which incorporated Senator Arasmith's amendments, but included an amendment to prohibit the apportionment of the Senate in 1989. Senator Gannon seconded the motion. The motion failed. Senator Arasmith's motion was then voted on, and it carried. Senator Montgomery moved that HCR 5003 be passed as amended, seconded by Senator F. Kerr. Motion carried.

The minutes of the March 24, 1987 meeting were approved, and Senator Yost adjourned the meeting at 5:50 p.m.
