The Chairman announced that HCR-5007 could be removed from the books as it had been voted on in the Senate. This bill was assigned to Senate Public Health and Welfare Committee February 26, 1987, and was withdrawn March 2 and rereferred to the committee on Energy and Natural Resources.

Senator Bond moved to pass HCR-5017 out favorable for passage. Senator Anderson seconded the motion. The motion carried.

The chairman asked the wishes of the committee on SCR-1601.

Senator Francisco moved to pass HB-2137 out favorable for passage. Senator Hayden seconded the motion.

Senator Salisbury made a substitute motion to delete subsection (f). Senator Hayden seconded the motion. The motion carried.

Senator Francisco moved to pass HB-2137 out favorable for passage as amended. Senator Mulich seconded the motion. The motion carried.

The chairman asked the wishes of the committee concerning SB-397.

Senator Hayden moved to amend SB-397 as requested by the Emergency Medical Services. Senator Mulich seconded the motion. The motion carried.

Senator Anderson moved to pass SB-397 out favorable for passage as amended. Senator Kerr seconded the motion. The motion carried.
