Action on S.B. 395 - Speed limits on nonurbanized interstate highways.

The Chairman said the since Congress had voted to override President Reagan's veto on the speed limit it was necessary to pass this bill in order to waive the 60-day waiting period. The Governor had requested that the effective date of this bill be May 1, 1987.

A motion was made by Sen. Martin and was seconded by Sen. Bond to amend S.B. 395 on page 2, in line 74, by inserting before "its" the following: "May 1, 1987, and". Motion carried.

A motion was made by Sen. Norvell and was seconded by Sen. Bond to recommend S.B. 395, as amended, favorably for passage. Motion carried with Sen. Doyen requesting to be recorded as voting "No".
