Chairman Campbell informed the Committee that the reason for the meeting was to adopt two resolutions which had previously been accepted by the Committee and read in the House of Representatives. They are:

HCR 5059 which is a concurrent resolution urging the United States Environmental Protection Agency to review its policy in regard to labeling and re-packaging bulk pesticides; and,

HR 6076 which is a resolution urging the Secretary of Transportation of the United States, James H. Burnley IV, to withdraw the proposed rule concerning reclassification of anhydrous ammonia.

Representative Crumbaker moved that HCR 5059 and HR 6076 be adopted by the members of the Committee. Representative Mollenkamp seconded the motion. The motion passed.
