Per request of the Governor, a bill was presented for introduction that provides for a state general fund operating grant for Washburn University under the state Board of Regents and repeals credit-hour aid and out-district state aid. Representative Heinemann moved for introduction of the bill. Seconded by Representative Hamm. Motion carried.

Larry Montgomery, Executive Director, Kansas Lottery, presented an overview of the Lottery operation and provided a handout containing Lottery revenue projections (Attachment 1). He stated his primary commitment to the Governor was to run the Lottery as a business taking note of the bottom line profitibility, but remaining sensitive to the Kansans (30%) who voted against the lottery.

Two areas of emphasis in the establishment of the Lottery are security and research. The legislation includes stringent security demands on retailers, lottery personnel, and vendors. Mr. Montgomery made the decision to have security clearances completed on employees before they begin working. For this reason, the Lottery still has a 22 percent vacancy rate.

Regarding research, the Lottery studied what had been successful in other similar states and surveyed attitudes in Kansas. One-half the people surveyed wanted the instant game with lots of winners and one-half wanted large prizes. Lotto games have failed in other states because of lack of population to generate a large prize, so Kansas went to a multi-state lottery.

On January 23, 1988, Kansas started the first ever in the United States live "draw" show. The Kansas Lottery will be taking the show on the road to a different community each week believing this will maintain interest and demonstrate the security and fairness of the games.

An important function for the Lottery is to help create funding for KTEC, Department of Commerce, Kansas Venture Capital, Inc. and Kansas Inc. To date, the Kansas Lottery has given to the state \$4,635,000.

The Lottery utilizes two methods of accounting—accrual accounting to project in the future what money will accrue and cash basis accounting for the purposes of state government. Final accounting for a game cannot take place until 180 days after the beginning, because that is the deadline for validation of winning tickets.
