Mike Johnson, Kansas State University

SB 753 - An Act authorizing the state board of regents to sell certain real property on behalf of Kansas state university of agriculture and applied science; imposing conditions thereon; authorizing disposition of proceeds.

Mike Johnson, Kansas State University, explained that this bill authorizes Kansas State University to sell three missile sites that are no longer used by the University. The proceeds would be placed in a restricted fee account to the credit of the College of Engineering and would be used to purchase equipment. Representative Chronister moved that SB 753 be recommended favorably for passage. Seconded by Representative Hoy. Motion carried.

Regarding SB 711 which was heard in Committee on 4-6-88, Representative Lowther made a motion to remove SB 711 from the table. Seconded by Representative Chronister. Motion carried. This bill was previously amended to exclude law enforcement officers that have not had 320 hours of training. Representative Lowther stated that this bill is needed to allow statutory authority to university police to take various actions in emergency situations with regard to individuals considered to be mentally ill. Representative Vancrum noted that his concerns about the bill have been addressed. Representative Lowther made a motion that SB 711, as amended, be recommended favorably for passage. Seconded by Representative Dyck. Motion carried.

Representative Ott made a motion that the minutes of April 5 and 6, 1988 be approved as presented. Seconded by Representative Heinemann. Motion carried.

The meeting was adjourned at 12:00 noon.
