MINUTES OF THE SENATE COMMITTEE ON ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT

The meeting was called to order at 12:30 p.m. by the Chairman, Senator Wint Winter, Jr..

Harland Priddle, Secretary of the Kansas Department of Commerce, discussed the structure of KDOC and introduced the Director, or that Director's representative, of each of its five divisions. The Secretary then gave an overview of the Department's Annual Report. (A copy of that report is on file in the Kansas Legislative Research Department, Room 545-N, Statehouse.)

Dr. William Brundage, President, Kansas Technology Enterprise Corporation (KTEC), presented a brief overview of that Corporation's operations. He told the Committee that KTEC has finished its business plan and that it will be distributed next week. The plan will show what KTEC wants to do, how those things will be done and what the cost will be. He observed that this plan will be revised each year.

Dr. Brundage discussed the Governor's budget recommendations for KTEC and said that the current recommendations would decrease the amount KTEC received this current fiscal year by \$413,000.00. He stated that KTEC needs help in getting that recommended amount raised. KTEC feels that it needs \$3.4 million this year plus it needs to be able to take some of the gaming money it receives this fiscal year and move it into FY 1989. Dr. Brundage observed that KTEC has a lot of work ahead of it and will have to ask for a lot more money next year than it is asking for this year.

The Chairman said that a review of the budget recommendations for economic development activities will be given to the Committee next week.

Senator Vidricksen moved that the Minutes of the January 21, 1988, meeting of the Committee be approved. Senator Salisbury seconded the motion. The motion carried.

The meeting was adjourned by the Chairman at 1:30 p.m..
