MINUTES OF THE Senate COMMITTEE ON Governmental Organization

The meeting was called to order by Senator Vidricksen at

With a quorum present the Chairman called the meeting to order for the purpose of taking final action on several bills.

Attention was first turned to SB 748 concerning land surveyors. Senator Bogina made a conceptual motion to open the window on licensing for 90 days with the expiration date of September 30, 1988. Senator Frey seconded this and the motion carried. Senator Bogina then made a motion to pass SB 748 favorably. This was seconded by Senator Johnston and the motion carried.

HB 3095 relating to licensure, certification or registration of certain professionals was discussed and Mark Burghart again explained that Social Security numbers were needed to help identify non-filers. Chip Wheelen was present to express opposition from the Medical Society. He distributed copies of a balloon version with proposed amendments to this bill. (Exhibit A) Senator Frey made a motion to delete all but the proposed language for line 29 which would insert "whose application lists a Kansas address". This was seconded by Senator Johnston and the motion carried. A motion was then made by Senator Johnston to recommend HB 3095 favorable for passage as amended. This was seconded by Senator Bogina and the motion carried.

The committee then looked at HB 3083 concerning state institutions under the jurisdiction of the Secretary of Social and Rehabilitation Services. A motion was made by Senator Johnston and seconded by Senator Francisco to recommend this bill as favorable for passage. Motion carried.

A motion was made to recommend HB 2700, which would establish the Kansas Department of Civil Air Patrol, as favorable for passage by Senator Frey. This was seconded by Senator Johnston and the motion carried.

The meeting was then adjourned by the Chairman at 10:00 a.m.

0017 AN ACT relating to licensure, certification or registration of  
0018 certain professionals; requiring the submission of certain in-  
0019 formation.

0020 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

0021 Section 1. (a) In addition to any information required to be  
0022 submitted to a state authority by an applicant for original licen-  
0023 sure, certification or registration as an attorney, accountant, den-  
0024 tist, physician, real estate broker or salesperson or securities  
0025 agent or broker-dealer, (or a renewal thereof) the applicant shall  
0026 be required to provide the social security number of such appli-  
0027 cant and the applicant's spouse. Annually. Upon request of the  
0028 director of taxation, each such authority shall provide to the  
0029 director of taxation a listing of all such applicants, along with  
0030 such applicant's and spouse's social security numbers number  
0031 and address.
