Senate Bill 532 - Probate code, qualifications of fiduciaries.

Ron Smith, Kansas Bar Association, appeared to explain the bill. He stated often the fiduciary is appointed by the court and there is no reason to go through this. There should be no requirement when it is not required. A committee member inquired what is to be gained by taking it out? Mr. Smith replied they feel it is a surplus process. Following further committee discussion, the chairman asked Mr. Smith to correspond with the person who had requested the bill to get more information.

Senate Bill 533 - Professional corporation, withdrawing or retiring shareholders.

The chairman announced Lee Hornbaker had requested the bill but was unable to appear. The bill will be scheduled another day.

Senate Bill 424 - Amendments to Kansas Law Enforcement Training Act.

Following committee discussion, Senator Feleciano moved to amend the bill by adopting the recommendation of the League of Kansas Municipalities in lines 113 and 114 to clarify the language. Senator Parrish seconded the motion. The motion carried. Senator Feleciano moved to adopt the recommendation of the Kansas League of Municipalities in line 176. Senator Hoferer seconded the motion. The motion carried. Senator Feleciano moved to amend the bill in line 182 regarding civil penalty as recommended by the League of Kansas Municipalities. Senator Parrish seconded the motion. The motion carried. Senator Winter made a conceptual motion to amend the bill to allow the commission to assess costs against the employer. Senator Gaines seconded the motion. The motion carried. Senator Talkington moved that staff correct any errors in the bill. Senator Parrish seconded the motion. The motion carried. Senator Winter moved to report the bill favorably as amended. Senator Hoferer seconded the motion. The motion carried.
