George Barbee, Kansas Consulting Engineers, requested a bill be introduced as a committee bill concerning code of civil procedure. Following his explanation, Senator Gaines moved to introduce the bill. Senator Langworthy seconded the motion. The motion carried.

Senate Bill 111 - Crime of causing injury while driving under the influence of alcohol or drugs.

The chairman read the fiscal note to the committee. Following committee discussion, Senator Talkington made a conceptual motion to amend the bill in line 28 to change class E felony to class A misdemeanor and to further amend the bill to include reckless, fleeing and alluding in K.S.A. 8-1566, K.S.A. 8-1567 and K.S.A. 8-1588. Senator Steineger seconded the motion. The motion carried. Senator Talkington moved to report the bill favorably as amended. Senator Burke seconded the motion. The motion carried.

House Bill 2240 - Forfeitures; controlled substances, simulated controlled substances and drug paraphernalia.

Committee discussion was held concerning the six recommendations of the interim committee. Senator Steineger moved to amend the bill to provide the standard of promptness. Senator Burke seconded the motion. The motion carried. Further committee discussion was held concerning forfeiture procedure. Staff pointed out to the chairman there are some major printing errors in the bill, and the bill probably needs to be reprinted. Consideration of the bill was discontinued until the problems can be worked out.

The meeting adjourned.
