MINUTES OF THE SENATE COMMITTEE ON JUDICIARY

Conferees appearing before the committee:

Jim Yonally, Kansas Association of Security Alarm Companies, requested a bill be introduced to allow security alarm companies to limit their liability for contract. Following the explanation, Senator Gaines moved the bill be introduced. Senator Burke seconded the motion. The motion carried.

Committee discussion was held on House Bill 2287 concerning an amendment that will be offered on the Senate floor to remove the word recklessly. There was little objection on the part of committee members to the floor amendment.

Senate Bill 547 - Crime to knowingly make false allegation of child abuse and neglect.

The chairman explained the bill. A committee member commented there might be reluctance of a teacher and other people to report these things and this might provide an excuse not to report it. Following committee discussion and consideration of a proposed amendments, Senator Gaines moved to table the bill. Senator Parrish seconded the motion. The motion carried.

House Bill 2040 - Traffic offenses committed by juveniles, application of juvenile codes.

Senator Hoferer reviewed the bill. Following committee discussion, Senator Gaines moved to report the bill favorably. The motion failed for lack of a second.

House Bill 2260 - Mandatory sentence for crimes with firearms, exceptions.

Following committee discussion crime committed with a firearm, Senator Gaines moved to amend the bill to provide rebuttable presumption on first time offenses. Senator Winter seconded the motion. No further action will be taken on the bill until staff brings language back on the amendment for committee consideration.

The meeting adjourned.
