The Chairman, Senator Bogina, welcomed the Committee and called attention to the Committee member's refinished chairs. Ed Ahrens introduced Scott Rothe and Russ Mills, the newly appointed coordinators for the Committee and Ellen Piekalkiewicz who is new to the Legislative Research Department staff. Following discussion, Senator Johnston volunteered to serve as the minority member on the Wichita State University and Kansas Technical Institute Subcommittee.

Senator Doyen moved, Senator Johnston seconded, the recommendation for the introduction of bill draft 7 RS 1832, an act making and concerning appropriations for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1988, for the attorney general and attorney general -- Kansas bureau of investigation; authorizing certain transfers, imposing certain restrictions and limitations, and directing or authorizing certain receipts and disbursements and acts incidental to the foregoing. The Chairman explained that this bill has been requested by the Governor's Office and he noted that the bill is an emergency supplemental which is twofold. One issue is a tort claim which is to be paid by the Attorney General's Office and was received too late to be included in the last Finance Council agenda. The other item is an appropriation to the KBI to be used for background searches of the racing permit applications for race tracks. The motion carried.
