H.B. 2634 (Richard)

Three revenue transfers become demand transfers . . . State Highway Fund transfer, City-County Highway Fund transfer, and \$4.0 million transfer to Workers Compensation Fund. (Legislative Budget Committee -- Proposal No. 19)

H.B. 2635 (Richard)

Refund of retailers' sales taxes upon food. (Legislative Budget Committee -- Proposal No. 19)

H.B. 2636 (Gloria)

Service agreements -- scholarships for students in schools of medicine and osteopathic medicine. (Legislative Budget Committee -- Proposal No. 19)

H.B. 2638 (Carolyn)

Professional practice incentive grants -- service in an underserved area or field designated by Board of Education. (Legislative Educational Planning Council -- Proposal No. 23)

H.B. 2644 (Robin)

Enacts KANWORK Act -- establishes a work experience and training program for public assistance recipients. (Special Committee on Ways and Means-SRS -- Proposal No. 38)

S.B. 463 (Alan)

Retirant health care benefits program. (Special Committee on Ways and Means -- Proposal No. 36)

S.B. 464 (Alan)

Group health care benefit eligibility for retired local government employees. (Special Committee on Ways and Means -- Proposal No. 36)
