HB 2794 - Appropriations for FY 1989, state board of regents and higher education institutions.

Following Senator Harder's review, Senator Harder moved, Senator Feleciano seconded, to accept the Senate Subcommittee Report on HB 2974 and HB 2796 pertaining to Kansas State University and Kansas State University Veterinary Medical Center. The motion carried on a voice vote.

Senator Harder moved, Senator Werts seconded, to report HB 2794 favorably as amended. The motion carried on a roll call vote.

HB 2719 - Multiyear appropriations, capital improvements for certain state agencies.

Senator Feleciano moved, Senator Harder seconded, to report HB 2719 favorably as amended. The motion carried on a roll call vote.

HB 2796 - Appropriations for FY 1988, supplemental appropriations for various state agencies.

The Chairman explained that a request by the Attorney General's Office had been received asking that a Work Study Reimbursement Fund be established with no limit. The Attorney General's Office will hire law students to participate in the University of Kansas Work Study Program. Senator Werts moved, Senator Kerr seconded, the establishment of the Work Study Reimbursement Fund with no limit for the Attorney General's Office. The motion passed on a voice vote.

The Chairman reviewed a request by the Secretary Of Commerce for the transfer of funds from the Super Collider account. Senator Werts moved, Senator Feleciano seconded, to amend HB 2796 according to the attached proposed amendment. (Attachment 1) The motion passed on a voice vote.

Senator Feleciano moved, Senator Gannon seconded, to report HB 2796 favorably as amended. The motion carried on a roll call vote.

Sub. for HB 3005 - State capital improvements, fees for project architects.

During discussion, the Chairman stated that it was his understanding that this bill was requested by the Division of Architectural Services. Following discussion, it was the consensus of the Committee to take no action on Sub. for HB 3005.

SB 753 - State board of regents authorized to sell certain real property, improvements thereon and easements on behalf of Kansas state university.

On page 2, following line 77, by inserting the following:

"Existing industry development..... 30,669";

Also on page 2, in line 83, by striking "\$12,216" and inserting in lieu thereof "\$42,885";

On page 3, following line 108, by inserting the following:

"(d) On the effective date of this act, of the \$250,000 appropriated for the above agency for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1988, by section 8(a) of chapter 35 of the 1987 Session Laws of Kansas from the state general fund in the special projects account, the sum of \$30,669 is hereby lapsed."
