SB 769 - State fair capital improvements fund, establishment and use, appropriations for FY 1988 and FY 1989.

Staff reviewed SB 769. Senator Kerr pointed out that, as outlined in line 0037, five percent of the total gross receipts will equal only \$125,000 which is a reduction from past years. Senator Bogina suggested that the legislature should continue to monitor the capital improvement requests.

Senator Kerr moved, Senator Talkington seconded, to report SB 769 favorably. The motion carried on a roll call vote.

SB 773 - Municipal universities, ad valorem tax levies for operation and support.

Staff reviewed SB 773. Senator Johnston moved, Senator Kerr seconded, to report SB 773 favorably for passage. The motion passed on a roll call vote.

INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

Senator Doyen moved, Senator Werts seconded, to introduce a bill to provide for a 50 percent income tax rebate for one year for school districts for the 1987 taxable year. The motion carried on a voice vote.
