The meeting was called to order by Chairman Crumbaker.

Chairman Crumbaker introduced Mr. Dale Dennis of the Department of Education to give further explanation of the School Finance formula.

Mr. Dennis walked through the formula as explained by Mr. Barrett at yesterday's meeting by giving an example of USD #343's estimated General Fund State Aid for the 1988-89 school year. (Attachment 1). Mr. Dennis gave further explanation of how assessed valuations are adjusted. (Attachment 2).

A Sales Ratio Study (Attachment 3) comparing the urban and rural ratios from 1983 through 1988 was discussed by Mr. Dennis.

Mr. Dennis concluded his presentation by handing to the committee members a computer printout (Attachment 4) which analyzes the current School District Equalization Act and its effect on individual school district for the 1987-1988 school year. Mr. Dennis pointed out the high correlation between high district wealth and low ratio; i.e. as the wealth per pupil decreases, the ratio increases.

A time of discussion followed Mr. Dennis' presentation.

The meeting was adjourned by the chair at 4:23 p.m.

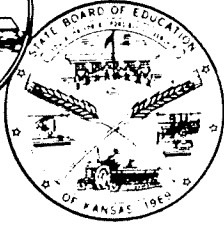

- Column 1 - September 20, 1987, FTE enrollment
- Column 2 - 1987-88 District wealth per pupil (1.75-year average of adjusted valuation and taxable income)
- Column 3 - 1987-88 Ratio of state aid to general fund budget (general state aid, 100% of income tax rebate, P.L. 874 receipts deducted in computing general state aid divided by school districts' general fund budgets)
- Column 4 - 1987-88 Ratio of state aid and local effort deductions to general fund budget (general state aid, 100% of income tax rebate, P.L. 874 receipts, motor vehicle tax to general fund, motor vehicle stamp tax to general fund, IRB payments in lieu of taxes to general fund) (EXCLUDES local effort rate times district wealth)

As you review the ratios in Column 4, it is significant that you notice there is a high correlation between high district wealth and low ratio. In other words, as the wealth per pupil decreases, the ratio increases. This is true in most enrollment categories, if not all.
