The meeting was called to order by Chairman Don Crumbaker.

The chairman announced HB 2089, an act concerning unified school district No. 295, Sedgwick County, Kansas; deeming certain children to be residents for school attendance, was open for discussion and possible action and recognized Representative Bowden.

Representative Bowden moved HB 2089 be passed favorably by the committee. Seconded by Representative Wiard.

Representatives Pottorff and Ramirez voiced their concerns about passing out a bill when there was litigation pending regarding the bill.

Representative Reardon made a substitute motion that HB 2089 be tabled. Seconded by Representative Hensley. The chair ruled the motion failed and a division was called for and the vote showed 7 YES, 10 NO. Motion lost.

A period of discussion followed.

Chairman Crumbaker called for a vote on the motion to pass HB 2089 favorably. The motion passed.

The chairman drew attention to the minutes for February 6, 1989; February 8, 1989; and February 9, 1989.

Representative Amos moved the minutes for February 6, February 8, and February 9, 1989 be approved. Seconded by Representative R. D. Miller. Motion carried.
