The meeting of the House Governmental Organization Committee was called to order by Representative Thomas F. Walker, Chairman.

Members introduced themselves and the Chairman introduced staff.

Chairman Walker explained the sunset review process. He also went over HB 2017 which came out of an interim study, and HB 2022 by Representative Foster.

There will be two major reviews by the Committee this session; the Water Office and Water Authority, and the Department of Revenue. In addition, one of the seven divisions of SRS will be reviewed. This year the Division of Administration, headed by Sandy Duncan, will come before the Committee.

The Chairman stated that the Committee has worked well together in the past. The Committee will search for the truth; the majority will rule.

As a rule, the Committee will not meet on Monday, but will usually meet Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday. If necessary, the Committee will meet on Friday. Meetings will try to be held within an hour time frame, but will never last beyond 10:30 a.m.

Chairman Walker stated the two bills dealing with the Water Office and Water Authority needed to be introduced.

Representative Miller moved that the Water Office and Water Authority legislation be introduced. Representative Gjerstad gave a second to the motion. The motion carried.
