MINUTES OF THE House COMMITTEE ON Insurance

The Chairman called the meeting to order at 3:30 p.m.

The Committee held discussion and action on a number of bills that had been heard previously in the Committee.

The first bill to be discussed was HB 2060 which would allow Insurance Companies both Non-Life and Life, the right to covered call options on U.S. Government obligations. Representative Littlejohn made the motion that HB 2060 be passed and placed on the consent calendar. Representative Brown seconded and the motion carried.

The Committee then took up HB 2061 which would amend the Kansas municipal group-funded pool act; limiting the number of persons serving on the board of trustees. Representative Brown made a motion that HB 2061 be passed and placed on the consent calendar. Representative Turnquist seconded. The motion carried.

The next bill to be discussed was HB 2062 which would require spouse and child coverage under group life insurance policies. Representative Sawyer made a motion that HB 2062 be passed and Representative Bryant seconded. The motion carried.

There were no other bills to be discussed and the meeting adjourned at 3:50 p.m.
