Conferees appearing before the committee:

Chairman Snowbarger called the meeting to order. Mary Galligan, Research, explained Attachment 1, a 3-page summary report; Attachment 2, a 74-page document listing, precinct by precinct, each of the districts; and Attachment 3, maps of Lawrence, Salina, Manhattan, Hutchinson, Wyandotte County, Garden City, Sedgwick County, Johnson County, Shawnee County, Leavenworth/Lansing, Emporia and a state-wide map.

Chairman Snowbarger provided background information relating to the development of the present map. A small working group (Representatives Adam, Miller, Roe, Snowbarger, and Whiteman) began with the 12 maps submitted by the 8 sub-committees and developed a complete map. Last Monday a press release was sent out, announcing public hearings for tomorrow. Last Thursday's mailing to each committee member included a reminder of this meeting, copy of their particular district, and advisory note that they could pick up packets this morning to study prior to the meeting. Also a memo was sent to every House member with a description of their particular districts.

Committee criteria was the number one basis for determining how to draw the districts. In doing that the group used information provided by committee members who had previously worked on maps. Agreement was reached on which seats were to be combined, and progressed on to the map to be presented today.

Chairman Snowbarger presented the proposed statewide map. Old District numbers that were combined are: Representative Brady (6) and Representative Lacey (2); Representatives Peterson (33) and Reardon (37); Representatives Roy (53) and Wagnon (55); Representatives Eckert (60) and Larkin (62); Representatives Fry (105) and Buehler (113); and Representatives Roe (109) and Littlejohn (119). New District numbers are 14, 15, 16, and 17 in Johnson County plus 99 and 100 in Sedgwick County. The map was presented and discussed by regions.

Meeting adjourned at 3 p.m. until 9 a.m. April 25, 1989.
