Chair called meeting to order, calling attention to HCR 5002. He noted this Resolution came out of Interim Study and urges the United States Secretary of Department of Health and Human Services to establish a policy to reimburse small, rural hospitals under the medicare program on the same basis as urban hospitals.

He asked wishes of members in regard to HCR 5002. Rep. Green moved to recommend favorable passage of HCR 5002, motion seconded by Rep. Foster. Minimal discussion held. Vote taken, motion carried.

Chair drew attention to committee minutes. Rep. Amos moved to approve minutes of January 11th and 12th. Motion seconded by Rep. Hochhauser, motion carried.

Chair noted meetings Wednesday and Thursday this week will be held in 313-S. Bill requests will be forthcoming from Ks. Board of Healing Arts, and possibly from some individuals.
