A motion was made by Representative Wagnon and seconded by Representative Vancrum to introduce a bill regarding grain tax appeals. The motion carried.

A motion was made by Representative Vancrum and seconded by Representative Reardon to introduce a bill that would allow taxpayers to initiate an informal appeal until the later of March 31st or 30 days following receipt of their new appraised value. The motion carried.

A motion was made by Representative Vancrum and seconded by Representative Guldner to amend HB 2516 to change the date in line 45 from September 1 to November 1. The motion carried with a vote count of 9 yes and 8 no.

A motion was made by Representative Reardon and seconded by Representative Snowbarger to pass HB 2516 as amended. The motion carried.

A motion was made by Representative Fry and seconded by Representative Guldner to pass HB 2515. The motion carried.

The meeting adjourned.

Secretary of Revenue Ed Rolfs conducted a tour of the Revenue Department and explained the tax refund process, the computer set-up between the Department and the counties, and other Department functions.
