Two concurrent resolutions were reviewed and discussed by the Committee.

House Concurrent Resolution No. 5019 - a concurrent resolution designating the post rock area of central and north-central Kansas as an area of historic and tourist interest and directing the Secretary of Transportation to indicate such area on the department's official travel maps.

House Concurrent Resolution No. 5020 - a concurrent resolution concerning the redesignation of the Kansas Tourism Regions; encouraging the Kansas Department of Commerce to redesignate the five existing Kansas Tourism Region boundaries to correspond with the six existing KDOC Field Office regions.

It was moved by Senator Feleciano and seconded by Senator Karr that House Concurrent Resolutions No. 5019 and No. 5020 be adopted. Motion carried, resolutions adopted.
