MINUTES OF THE SENATE COMMITTEE ON EDUCATION

Following a call to order, Chairman Joseph C. Harder announced that the Committee would discuss HB 2085, relating to school finance, which was heard by the Committee yesterday, and he hoped the Committee could arrive at a consensus regarding this proposal. The Chairman reviewed the provisions of the bill as it left the House.

The Chairman inquired if the Committee wished to agree on the budget control limitations of 102 percent and 104 percent. Senator Parrish moved to amend HB 2085 by increasing budget limitations to 103 percent and 106 percent, with a one percent additional optional budget authority, subject to a five percent protest petition. The motion was seconded by Senator Walker. Responding to a Committee question, Mr. Dale Dennis of the State Department of Education, estimated that an additional \$24million above the current level of funding established by the House would be needed to fund Senator Parrish's motion. When the Chairman called for a vote on Senator Parrish's motion, he announced that it had failed. Following a call for a division, he confirmed that the motion had failed by a vote of six nays and five yeas.

The Chairman announced that the next item of discussion was whether or not to retain deduction of the income tax rebate as part of the formula. Responding to Committee discussion, Mr. Dale Dennis noted that the districts which would be helped most by the income tax rebate provision are those with high taxable income included in the district wealth. Following discussion on the income tax rebate deduction, and hearing no motions from the floor, the Chairman ruled that the House version of local effort, as it relates to income tax rebate deduction, remains unchanged.

The Chairman next referred the Committee's attention to consideration of the provision in HB 2085 which averages district wealth over a period of two years. The Chairman commented that he felt the two sets of figures were not compatible, since the previous year's wealth included merchants' and manufacturers' inventories and livestock, and these are not included in the wealth factor for this year.

The Chairman then called upon Mr. Dale Dennis of the State Department of Education, who distributed computer printout L8955 (Attachment 1). Mr. Dennis noted that this printout was the first one which had been requested yesterday by Senator Montgomery and approved by the Committee. He said that the printout represents a two-year average of district wealth but excludes merchants' and manufacturers' inventories and livestock and two-thirds of the business machinery in 1988, which is based upon the amount anticipated to be going off the tax rolls in 1989. It is the same version as that of the House, he continued, except for these exclusions. Mr. Dennis also distributed computer printout L8958 (Attachment 2), which, he said, had been requested by the Chairman and is a comparison summary of three different school finance plans based upon the House version of HB 2085 except for the definition of district wealth.

Unless specifically noted, the individual remarks recorded herein have not been transcribed verbatim. Individual remarks as reported herein have not been submitted to the individuals appearing before the committee for editing or corrections.

Mr. Dennis continued his explanation of the printouts.

When the Chair called for Committee action regarding school district wealth, Senator Frahm moved that the Committee amend HB 2085 and use "one year" averaging in the formula for district wealth. Senator Allen seconded the motion. Responding to Committee questions, Mr. Dale Dennis replied that as a general rule the rural areas, especially the unirrigated ones, and those districts which are losing a lot of inventory from the tax rolls will benefit the most under "one year" averaging. After the Chairman called for a vote on the pending motion to use "one year" averaging in the SDEA and following the Chairman's call for a division (six yeas and five nays), the Chair ruled that the amendment was adopted.

The Chairman then referred the Committee's attention to the hold harmless clause as the next consideration relating to HB 2085. He reminded the Committee that the House version calls for funding the hold harmless provision at 100 percent compared to last year's funding at 75 percent. He also commented that the hold harmless provision has a disequalizing tendency. Committee discussion indicated concern of a possible court challenge due to the disequalizing effect caused by a hold harmless provision. Responding to questions, Mr. Dennis informed members that using the House money of \$50million it would cost \$18million+ to fund the hold harmless provision at 100 percent and estimated that between thirty and forty districts would benefit from it.

Senator Montgomery moved to amend HB 2085 by funding the hold harmless provision at 50 percent. Senator Frahm seconded the motion.

Senator Karr made a substitute motion to amend HB 2085 by funding the hold harmless provision at 75 percent. The motion was seconded by Senator Walker, but the substitute motion was rejected.

When the Chair called for a vote on the original motion by Senator Montgomery to fund the hold harmless provision at 50 percent, he announced that the motion had failed. Following a call for a division (five yeas and six nays), the Chairman affirmed that the amendment was rejected. The Chairman stated that funding for the hold harmless provision in HB 2085 would remain at 100 percent.

The Committee, by consensus, directed Mr. Dennis to prepare computer runs using one year wealth, \$44million in the formula, and funding of the 100 percent hold harmless provision (estimated by Mr. Dennis to be around \$14million) in addition to the \$44million.

When the Chair asked if there was any further business, Senator Anderson proposed an amendment which, he said, had been submitted to the Committee yesterday by a representative of USD 259, Wichita. He explained that the amendment would allow students who are in the custody of SRS and attending schools such as the Judge Riddel Boys Ranch near Wichita to be counted as 2.0 full time equivalent students for budgetary purposes. He explained that this would alleviate certain expenses of districts involved in providing educational instruction to such schools. Senator Langworthy seconded the motion. Mr. Dale Dennis stated that the \$200,000 estimated cost actually involves more of a reshuffling of funds depending upon where the students are located. Senator Anderson related that funding for Riddel Boys Ranch had been worked out over a handshake agreement some years ago but now problems have arisen regarding this agreement. Senator Anderson, replying to a question, stated that the students who would be affected by this amendment are: 31 at Paola, 45 at Pittsburg, 24 in Dodge City, 30 in Topeka, and about 36 at Riddel Boys Ranch. Committee concerns included actual cost for educating these students and possible other schools which might be covered by this amendment.

When the Chair called for a vote on the proposed amendment, the Chair announced that the amendment was adopted.

Senator Parrish then proposed an amendment to HB 2085 whereby budget limitations would be 102 percent and 106 percent. She explained that this differential would provide for greater equalization, and she thought that this greater spread had been recommended by the Kansas Association of School Boards. Senator Karr seconded the motion. Mr. Dale Dennis, responding to a question, said this proposed amendment would probably equate to about \$14million in additional budget authority; but if all districts utilized it, it would come closer to \$20million. Senator Parrish then requested that her pending motion to amend HB 2085 be changed to 102 percent and 105 percent budget limitations, and the Committee agreed to this request. Responding to a question, Mr. Dennis stated that the property tax implication would be about \$10million. Senator Karr seconded the motion. Following the Chair's call for a division (six yeas and five nays), the Chairman ruled that the amendment was adopted.

Senator Allen moved that HB 2085, as amended, be recommended favorably for passage. The motion was seconded by Senator Frahm, and the motion carried.

The Chair adjourned the meeting.


