Senator Yost suggested a technical amendment to H.B. 2359. On page 2 in (d) he would like to insert the word state after each and before party. Also in (e) strike the word state in line one and also line five.

Senator Yost made a motion to amend this into H.B. 2359 to make a substitute bill with the technical amendments in it. Senator Kerr seconded the motion. The motion carried.

Senator Yost mentioned that he had checked with the Public Disclosure Commission about penalties if a candidate took money he wasn't entitled to he would be requested to refund the money with little fanfare and embarrassment.

Senator Yost made a motion to recommend the substitute bill favorably as amended. Senator Bond seconded the motion. Senator Rock made a substitute motion to appoint a subcommittee to study this substitute bill at least unto the veto session. Senator Martin seconded the motion. The substitute motion failed. The Senator's returned to the original motion Senator Yost made and the motion carried.
