Chairman Doyen welcomed committee members and made the following announcements: the committee would usually meet Tuesday through Thursday; he would appreciate members being on time; if members can not be present that they notify the committee secretary. He gave a brief outline of the subjects expected in committee this session. He then called on Mr. Gilliland to brief the committee on S.B. 6.

S.B. 6 - concerns hazardous waste; authorizing the establishment of certain hazardous waste collection programs. Mr. Gilliland stated the bill was recommended by the Special Committee on Energy and Natural Resources, as a result of Proposal No. 13 that was studied this summer. The Interim Committee report suggested to the Legislature that an initial \$150 thousand be appropriated to fund the state's portion. Mr. Gilliland responded to several questions.

Chairman Doyen announced the conferees would be heard at the meeting on January 18.
