MINUTES OF THE Senate COMMITTEE ON Federal & State Affairs

Chairman Reilly called the meeting to order.

Senator Strick moved the committee introduce a proposal which would affect Wyandotte County only and would prohibit residency in public housing if convicted of drug or alcohol abuse. Senator Anderson seconded and the motion passed.

Senator Vidricksen moved the committee introduce a proposal regarding simulcast races. Senator Anderson seconded and the motion passed. Senator Morris asked to be recorded as a "no" vote.

Discussion was held for SB 92 concerning public meetings and the preliminary discussion of land sale.

Senator Bond moved SB 92 be reported favorably for passage. Senator Anderson seconded and the motion passed.

Discussion was held on SB 200 which deals with using parimutuel proceeds by local governments.

Senator Strick made a conceptual motion which would allow the proceeds of the "handle" of a track to be applied to the county in which the track is located. Senator Yost seconded and the motion passed.

Staff was directed to clarify whether any changes could mean default on financial agreements.

Discussion was held on SB 90 which deals with Sunday sales of cereal malt beverage for off-premise consumption.

Senator Bond made a conceptual motion which would add "for licensees under its jurisdiction" after "resolution" on line 70 and after "ordinance" on line 72. Senator Anderson seconded and the motion passed.

Senator Strick moved an amendment to allow retail liquor stores to sell cereal malt beverage on Sunday. The bill died for lack of a second.

Senator Anderson moved SB 90 be passed as amended. Senator Morris seconded and the motion carried. Senator Daniels asked to be recorded as a "no" vote.

The meeting was adjourned at 11:55.
