Chairman Oleen noted that Secretary Rolfs and Susan Duffy of the Department of Revenue were present to answer any questions the committee might have.

SB 71 - Concerning sunset law for Department of Revenue and the office of Secretary of Revenue

Comments were made regarding the necessity of a sunset law for state agencies.

Motion was made by Senator Doyen to favorably recommend SB 71; seconded by Senator Francisco. Motion carried.

SB 204 - Concerning the employee suggestion award program

Senator Francisco stated he has learned the state employees are in favor of the proposal, but are not permitted to request or lobby for specific legislation that might impact them.

Motion was made by Senator Strick to recommend favorably SB 204 ; seconded by Senator Doyen. Motion carried.

SB 206 Relating to law enforcement officers memorial.

Consensus of the committee was that this legislation is of value for a worthwhile project.

Motion was made by Senator Strick to recommend favorably SB 206; seconded by Senator Doyen. Motion carried.

Discussion was held regarding SB 66. A companion bill HB 2075 remains in the House Governmental Organization Committee for discussion and possible amendments. SB 66 will remain in committee.
