HB 2555- State records center transfer to the Historical Society

Chairman Oleen requested the committee meet to discuss HB 2555 in order to address concerns expressed by Ramon Powers, Secretary of the Historical Society. Currently, the Historical Society has the responsibility of maintaining the inactive records of state agencies and departments, but statutory authority has not been granted to the Society to perform this function. HB 2555 does not provide for any expenditures, but will allow the Secretary of the Historical Society to proceed with the development of a record center to serve as a depository for inactive records.

Discussion by committee members favored expeditious action to provide the necessary continuity for development of the center and retention of current policies regarding record storage.

Motion was made by Senator Strick to recommend favorably HB 2555; seconded by Senator Kanan. Motion carried.
