The Chairman announced that he and Senator Johnston were the Subcommittee members assigned for the Homestead Property Tax portion of HB 2029.

MINUTES

Senator Harder moved, Senator Doyen seconded, the approval of the minutes from the February 13, 14 and 16, 1989 meetings. The motion carried.

SB 27 -- Appropriations for FY 1990, judicial branch, judicial council and state board of indigents' defense services

Senator Salisbury reviewed the subcommittee report for FY 1989 and FY 1990 regarding the Judicial Council and the State Board of Indigents' Defense Services. Senator Harder reviewed the subcommittee report for FY 1989 and FY 1990 regarding the Judicial Branch. In answer to a question regarding the recommendation to grant each justice and judge of the Judicial Branch an additional two percent base salary increase in FY 1990, staff stated that the current starting judges salary is \$60,978.

Concern was expressed regarding judges salaries being tied to the KCC, Board of Tax Appeals, and Parole Board salaries. <u>Senator Feleciano moved, Senator Kerr seconded</u>, to amend the subcommittee report by recommending the introduction of legislation decoupling the <u>Judge's salaries from those salaries presently tied to the court salaries by statute. Following discussion</u>, the motion carried.

Senator Harder moved, Senator Gaines seconded, to reformat SB 27 by dividing the appropriations into more than one item. The motion carried.

Senator Harder moved, Senator Salisbury seconded, to adopt the subcommittee report regarding SB 27 -- the judicial branch, judicial council and the state board of indigents' defense services, as amended. The motion carried.

Senator Harder moved, Senator Allen seconded, to report SB 27, as amended, favorably for passage. The motion carried on a roll call vote.
