INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

Conferees appearing before the committee:

Senator Johnston moved, Senator Burke seconded, the introduction of two bills relating only to new prison facilities relative to HB 2548. One bill is to make clear the legislative intent that local land use regulations not interfere with the state's ability to construct facilities pursuant to HB 2548. The other bill is to include the competitive bidding procedure and the public sale of bonds for the project. The decision was made to refer the two bills to the Committee of the Whole. The motion carried.

<u>HB 2099 - Enacting handicapped and elderly public transportation assistance act</u>

During discussion, it was stated that the assumption was if the highway bill does pass it will have the funding for the transportation for the handicapped and elderly as outlined in <u>HB 2099</u>. <u>Senator Feleciano made a conceptual motion to amend Section five</u>, page two, of HB 2099 by either deleting that section or rewriting it to conform with the appropriation language in HB 2014. The motion carried.

<u>Senator Feleciano moved, Senator Allen seconded, to report HB 2099, as amended, favorably for passage.</u> During discussion, the Chairman asked if anyone in the room wished to add comments or requests pertaining to <u>HB 2099</u>. There was no reply. <u>The motion carried on a roll call vote.</u>

There was a short discussion concerning bills remaining in Committee and the meeting was adjourned.
