MINUTES OF THE HOUSE COMMITTEE ON ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT

The meeting was called to order at 7:10 a.m. by Chairperson Baker.

Representative Baker called for discussion of HB 2792.

Representative Mead made a motion to change the words developer to promotor and the words development to promotion throughout the bill and to change line 40 to read \$500 instead of \$200. Representative Weimer seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Representative Weimer made a motion that HB 2792 be passed favorably, as amended. Representative Reinhardt seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Representative Baker called for discussion on HB 2783.

Representative Gjerstad made a motion to conceptually amend the bill by removing the provision giving unified school districts approval authority and to specifically provide for prior notice of proposed tax exemptions affecting unified school districts and all other taxing subdivisions including the issuance of industrial revenue bonds and certificates of participation for which tax exemptions are to be provided. Representative Brady seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Representative Brady made a motion that HB 2783 be passed favorably, as amended. Representative Reinhardt seconded the motion. Motion carried.

The meeting adjourned at 7:45 a.m.
