The meeting was called to order by Chairman Crumbaker.

The chairman introduced Ben Barrett from the staff to brief the committee on HCR 5055 and SCR 1640.

Mr. Barrett used two printouts to show the estimated effect on each unified school district if the state increased the sales tax by one and one-half cent effective October 1, 1990 which would lower the general fund property tax rate by 49.9 percent during the 1990-91 school year, (SCR 1640). HCR 5055 provides for a one cent sales tax increase effective December 1, 1990 and this would lower the general fund property tax rate by 28.5 percent during the 1990-91 school year.

Mr. Barrett answered questions from the committee during his presentation.
