The meeting was called for the purpose of assuring a quorum vote for introduction of the abortion and parental notification bills presented at the January 30, 1990, meeting of the committee.

Representative Long moved to introduce the bills, seconded by Representative Cates. The motion carried on a vote of 7-6.

Chairman Barr again requested the committee review the interim study on parimutuel in order to be briefed when that issue is addressed by the committee.

The option for the lottery to continue indefinitely was addressed by Representative Roy. He stated he had requested staff draft a bill with a four year sunset provision. Representative Long made a conceptual motion to introduce the bill as a committee bill, seconded by Representative Gjerstad. The motion was adopted.
