The House Labor and Industry Committee met at the rail for the purpose of introducing legislation as committee bills.

The first piece of legislation contained Workers Compensation Director's recommendations for amendments that would ease administration of or, remove inequities in, or encourage compliance with the Workers Compensation act as previously presented to the committee.

The second piece of legislation, raised in committee by Representative O'Neal, authorized an additional assistant to the rehabilitation administrator.

An additional piece of legislation, requested by Representative Douville, regarded compensation in cases involving injuries aggravated by medical treatment.

Representative Buehler moved that these three pieces of legislation be introduced.

Representative Holmes gave a second to the motion. The motion carried.

A fourth piece of legislation, requested by Representative O'Neal, related to disqualifying for unemployment compensation benefits of employees who fail drug tests due to off-the-job drug usage.

Representative O'Neal moved that this piece of legislation be introduced as a committee bill.

Representative Holmes gave a second to the motion. The motion carried.
