Staff presented a briefing on HB-2725, section by section, answering questions by committee members.

Considerable discussion evolved around the issue of funds allowed political action committees in the present form of the bill.

Senator Johnston moved that political action committees be allowed to receive, at a minimum, the same level as individuals. (This would raise the amount from \$3,000 to \$20,000.)

A substitute motion was made by Senator Yost to lower all figures to \$3,000. Senator Johnston seconded the motion. The motion failed.

Senator Kerr, with a second by Senator Bond, moved to report HB-2725 favorable for passage. The motion carried.

The meeting adjourned at 5:10 p.m.
