Senator Kerr moved, with a second from Senator Bond, HB-2706 favorable for passage. The motion carried.

The chairman placed Substitute HB-3065 before the committee noting he wished to strike the language in Sub. H B 3065 and replace it with the language of SB-417.

Discussion noted that a number of committee members had sponsored SB-417 and would like to see some type of movement on it.

Senator Yost moved, with a second from Senator Johnston, to strike all of the language in Sub. HB-3065 and replace it with the language of SB-417.
