Conferees appearing before the committee:

Chairman Oleen requested Julian Efird to review all bills remaining in Committee at the conclusion of the 1989 session. Any requests for bill introduction will be entertained.

Review and discussion by Committee as follows:

SB 66 Consolidation of administration of cosmetology and barber boards.

Consensus of the committee is to take no action now.

SB 191 - Use of national guard armories as shelters for homeless persons.

Senator Gaines, sponsor of the bill, feels other options are available and requests that the bill be retained in committee with no action.

SB 199 - Establishing the self-sufficiency trust fund.

Discussion of financial impact to families involved and to the state. A House bill addressed the issue last session.

SB 224 - Excavation construction, maintenance and repair

Adoption of this legislation would be duplication of federal laws and adding unneeded legislation.

SB 232 - Kansas Commission on Hispanic affairs.

No response from proponents of the bill as to the necessity of this particular legislation.

SB 241 - Licensure of auctioneers.

Chairman Oleen suggested members attend a scheduled meeting on January 18 with auctioneers to hear their concerns before action is taken.

SB 244 - Amendments to the civil service statutes.

This is a repealer bill regarding civil service employees.
SB 253 - Department of Commerce: office of housing established.

SB 427, which has been assigned to this committee relates to this bill.

SB 280 - Establishing the council on indigent health care.

Consideration will be given this legislation after it is determined if the AD Hoc Council is still functioning and is necessary.

Unless specifically noted, the individual remarks recorded herein have not been transcribed verbatim. Individual remarks as reported herein have not been submitted to the individuals appearing before the committee for editing or corrections.

SB 320 - Creating a division of surveys, mapping and geodetic control in the Department of Administration.

Committee expressed opposition to passage of this legislation.

SB 366 - Public records not required to be open

SB 379 - Regulation and licensure of private investigators and polygraphists examiners.

Concern regarding this bill has not been expressed this session. New legislation will be introduced addressing the issue.

SB 427 - Housing and housing related programs.

This is new legislation which will be under discussion by the committee at a later date.

SCR 1628 - Constitutional amendment relating to the legislature.

As this concerns the structure of the Senate and House, this will be given indepth discussion as to ramifications.

HB 2017 - Publication and disposition of Kansas statutes and legislative journals.

The expense of distribution of legislative materials has caused concern and distribution of additional copies to schools and libraries is under consideration.

HB 2231 - Continued existence of the Coal Commission.

HB 2466 - Practice of barbering; Kansas Board of Barbering, fees incresed.

Fee increase is needed for the continued existence of the board. A hearing will be held soon.

HB 2491 - Polygraphists' licensure and regulation.

Julian Efird suggested the review of the Civil Rights Commission sunset should be given by the committee, introduced RS 1943.

A motion was made by Senator Bogina to introduce RS 1943; seconded by Senator Strick. Motion carried.

Meeting adjourned. The next meeting will be January 22, 1990.
