AN ACT designating Interstate highway 635 as the Harry Darby memorial highway.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. Interstate highway 635 where it enters the state on the Kansas-Missouri line on the north, thence south to the junction with Interstate highway 35, is hereby designated as the Harry Darby memorial highway. The secretary of transportation shall place markers along the highway right-of-way at proper intervals to indicate that the highway is the Harry Darby memorial highway. The secretary of transportation may accept and administer gifts and donations to aid in obtaining and installing suitable highway signs bearing the proper approved inscription.

Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
