Chairman Hamm informed the committee of the need to amend SB 73 - Kansas Cooperative Marketing Act. He stated that everything before the new section 31, page 17, should be struck from the bill.

Raney Gilliland, Legislative Research, explained the amendment section by section.

After much discussion, Representative Gatlin made a conceptual motion to amend SB 73 by striking all language before New Sec. 31 and making necessary changes in related language. Seconded by Representative Correll. The motion carried.

A motion was made by Representative Rezac to pass favorably SB 73 as amended. Seconded by Representative Bryant. Motion carried.

Chairman Hamm asked the committee for recommendations of interest to the Agriculture Committee to be studied in the interim.

Representative Bryant suggested a possible interim study of the Veterinary Practice Act. This would be in relation to civil penalties.
