The meeting was called to order by Chairman Bowden.

The Chairman presented the Committee with three individual bill requests for consideration as Committee bills. The first was the Governor's proposal to phase out the out-district tuition for community colleges. A Motion was made by Rep. Empson to authorize the introduction of this bill. It was seconded by Rep. Harder. The Motion carried. The second bill to be introduced was in reference to a request from 501 School District (Topeka) regarding notification of truant students' parents. A Motion by Rep. Hensley to introduce the bill was made and it was seconded by Rep. Jones. The Motion carried. The third bill was in regard to vo-tech schools and the advisory council. A Motion by Rep. Reinhardt was made and seconded by Rep. Smith. The Motion carried.

Discussion and action on previously heard bills was opened by the Chairman. HB 2013 was discussed and a proposal to amend the bill by striking remedial instruction" in line 34 and by also striking "paraprofessional services, counseling and advising" in line 35. Rep. Wiard Motioned to amend the bill as noted. It was seconded by Rep. Harder. The Motion carried. The bill was amended. A Motion by Rep. Ramirez to favorably pass the bill out of committee was made and seconded by Rep. Pottorff. The Motion carried.

HB 2014 regarding the teacher scholarship program was brought to attention, no discussion took place. Rep. Reinhardt made a motion to pass this bill favorably out of committee. It was seconded by Rep. Praeger. The motion carried.

Chairman Bowden then referred to HB 2028 dealing with Washburn and the power of the Board of Regents. A Motion by Rep. Hensley to pass this bill favorably out of committee was made. It was seconded by Rep. Smith. Motion carried.

Rep. Lane made a Motion to approve the minutes for January 29, 1991. It was seconded by Rep. Jones. Motion carried. Minutes for January 30 and January 31, 1991 were handed out for review with action to be taken at the February 6 meeting.

The meeting was adjourned at 3:44 p.m. with the next meeting scheduled for Wednesday, February 6, 1991, in Rm 519-S.
