The meeting was called to order by Chairman Bowden upon adjournment of the House.

Chairman Bowden opened HB 2428 for discussion. Rep. Crumbaker made a motion to pass this bill favorably out of committee. It was seconded by Rep. Lahti. Motion carried.

HB 2208 regarding teaching braille to the blind in school was then opened for discussion. Rep. Lahti motioned to pass the bill favorably out of committee. It was seconded by Rep. Reardon. Avis Swartzman brought to attention that on page 2, line 5, the word 'department' should read 'board'. Rep. Lahti made a substitute motion to include the amendment to change page 2, line 5 to read 'board' instead of 'department' and that the bill should be passed, as amended, favorably out of committee. Motion carried.

The Chairman then opened HB 2388 to be discussed. Rep. Harder made a motion to pass the bill favorably out of committee. It was seconded by Rep. Reinhardt. Motion carried. HB 2388 was passed favorably out of committee.

Rep. Hensley moved that HB 2115 be removed from the table. It was seconded by Rep. Lahti. The motion carried.

The meeting was adjourned at 5:43 p.m. with the next meeting on call of the Chairman.
